Regional Director Banua also mentioned about giving priority to stunted children since stunted growth among children is currently one of the root causes of cyclical poverty in the country.

The activity was led by ESO Director Asst. Prof. Armando V. Mendoza Jr. together with the extension coordinators of the university.

The activity aimed to identify the needs of the locals from the beneficiary municipalities. Needs identified focused on livelihood, health and security, and education for the residents of Brgy. Nagtaluntong. Results of the consultation will be used as inputs for the identification of intervention activities for the barangay.

The Adopt-a-Municipality program is an extension program of the university that helps residents of recipient barangays in alleviating their condition.
