The workshop was attended by coordinators from all BatStateU

campuses and representatives from each college/department. Additionally, each of the 10-point extension agenda was covered by ESO officials and coordinators. The Extension Services Ten-Point Agenda include:

1. Environment and Natural Resources Conservation, Protection and Rehabilitation Program;
2. Technology Transfer, Utilization and Commercialization Program;
3. Technical Assistance and Advisory Program to Agencies, Organizations, Associations and Other Groups;
4. Technical-Vocational Education and Training (TVET) Program on Agri-Fishery and Related Program for Farmers and Fisherfolks
5. Adopt-A-Barangay Program and Social Development Program;
6. Parents' Empowerment through Social Development (PESODEV) Program; (continued on next page)
7. Disaster Preparedness and Response/Climate Change Adaptation;
8. Gender and Development;
9. Community Outreach Program; and
10. Smart Analytics and Engineering.

After the training workshop, a special session was conducted for the deliberation and formulation of work and financial plan of their project proposals scheduled for the first and second quarters of the year 2018.
