

BatStateU extensionists join series of Yakap Bayan Program in Calatagan, San Juan

The Batangas State University took part in the series of Community Outreach Activities and Yakap Bayan: Community Mobilization Support Program in CALABARZON, particularly in the municipalities of Calatagan (Oct 12) and San Juan (November 26).

The Batangas State University extended their assistance by donating raincoats to student beneficiaries, including 754 indigent pupils of Bukal, Hukay and Encarnacion Elementary schools in the municipality of Calatagan, and more than 150 day-care pupils in Barangay Laiya-Aplaya, San Juan, Batangas.

The program was made possible through the efforts of other government sectors and NGAs who provided various assistance and services to the community beneficiaries during the activity.

Initiated by the Regional Development Council (RDC) Region IV-A, the Yakap Bayan Program is an inter-agency convergence program that aims to bring government services closer to communities across the region to extend support and address issues on peace and order, and security and social protection.
