The main objective of the colloquium was to: ensure that the research proposals have scientific and technical merits; improve the methodologies of the proposals; ensure that the research proposals have scientific quality; and improve research capability.

On April 29, the Research Office hosted the 2019 Research Colloquium at BatStateU Pablo Borbon Main I. The event was attended by selected faculty researchers from the different campuses whose studies focus in two particular areas of discipline: Social Science, Education and Business Research; and Natural Sciences and Engineering Research.

During the parallel sessions, the participants were given 15 minutes to present their research proposals followed by a 10-minute Q&A portion where the participants received feedbacks and recommendations from the evaluators.
