Expertise: Farm management, good livestock handling.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Collecting (cut-and-carry) forage and grasses (morning and afternoon).
- Feeding of goats (morning and afternoon).
- Cleaning and disinfection of goat pens, cages, and yards (morning).
- Provision of drinking water to goats (morning and afternoon).
- Disposal of goat manure from the goat house (2-3 times weekly)
- Inventory of goats (weekly)
- Regular checking of animal health like provision of vitamins, cure, wounds, deworming (monthly)
- Assisting goats in mating
- Repairing of goat house and fences.
- Propagation of forage crops
- Weeding and cleaning of forage area to avoid completion of forage crops from weeds and other debris (weekly)
- Irrigation of planted forage in the forage area (especially during dry periods)
