Requirements for Regular Admission

1. Applicants must have completed high school in a recognized school, or must be enrolled in Senior High School, if not yet completed.
2. Applicants must submit the following:
 - a. E - copy of Filled –up Application Form (<https://dione.batstate-u.edu.ph/tao/#/application>)
 - b. E- copy of two (2) recent 2”x2” ID picture with white or plain background
 - c. Certified e- copy of final grades in Grades 8, 9, 10, and 11
 - Grades Form 1 or Grades Form 2
 - Junior High School Form 137
 - Senior High School Form 137
 - d. Certificate of Completion/Enrollment
3. The original hard copy of requirements will be submitted upon request of the Testing and Admission Office, the University Registrar, and/or College.

Requirements for applicants under the Affirmative Action Program

a. Indigent Student Applicants

- i. Applicants must have completed high school in a recognized school, or must be enrolled in Senior High School, if not yet completed.
- ii. Applicants must submit the following:
 - a. E - copy of Filled –up Application Form
 - b. E- copy of two (2) recent 2”x2” ID picture with white or plain background
 - c. Certified e- copy of final grades in Grades 8, 9, 10, and 11
 - Grades Form 1
 - Junior High School Form 137
 - Senior High School Form 137

The original hard copy of requirements will be submitted upon request of the Testing and Admission Office, the University Registrar, and/or College.
- iii. Certification of completion of SHS and respective strand or enrolment therein, if not completed;
- iv. Certification of indigency from their respective barangay and Income Tax Return of parent or guardian, if available

b. ALS graduates

- i. Applicants must have completed high school in a recognized school, or must be enrolled in Senior High School, if not yet completed.
- ii. Applicants must submit the following:
 - a. E - copy of Filled –up Application Form
 - b. E- copy of two (2) recent 2”x2” ID picture with white or plain background
 - c. Certified e- copy of final grades in Grades 8, 9, 10, and 11
 - Grades Form 2
 - Junior High School Form 137



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- Senior High School Form 137

The original hard copy of requirements will be submitted upon request of the Testing and Admission Office, the University Registrar, and/or College.

- iii. Certification of completion of ALS program, or enrolment therein, if not completed

c. Indigenous people

- i. Applicants must have completed high school in a recognized school, or must be enrolled in Senior High School, if not yet completed.
- ii. Applicants must submit the following:
 - a. E - copy of Filled –up Application Form
 - b. E- copy of two (2) recent 2”x2” ID picture with white or plain background
 - c. Certified e- copy of final grades in Grades 8, 9, 10, and 11

The original hard copy of requirements will be submitted upon request of the Testing and Admission Office, the University Registrar, and/or College.

- iii. Certification of completion of SHS and respective strand or enrolment therein, if not completed;
- iv. Certificate of Tribe Membership, or any equivalent certification as belonging to indigenous people/indigenous cultural community

d. PWD

- i. Applicants must have completed high school in a recognized school, or must be enrolled in Senior High School, if not yet completed.
- ii. Applicants must submit the following:
 - a. E - copy of Filled –up Application Form
 - b. E- copy of two (2) recent 2”x2” ID picture with white or plain background
 - c. Certified e- copy of final grades in Grades 8, 9, 10, and 11

- Senior High School Form 137

- iii. Certification of completion of SHS and respective strand or enrolment therein, if not completed;

Admission Application Procedure

1. Accomplish the College Admission Application Grades Form.
 - o Form 1 will be accomplished if the applicant graduated Junior High School (JHS) and Senior High School (SHS) level.
 - o Form 2 will be accomplished if the applicant took the Alternative Learning System (JHS Level) and regular admission to SHS.
2. Fill out the BatStateU College Application form at the (<https://dione.batstate-u.edu.ph/tao/#!/application>).
3. Upload the scanned copy of Certification of Grades of applicant for the following subjects for each grade level.

For Regular Admission, Indigenous Student, Indigenous People, and PWD:

- i. *Grades 8 to 10* - Mathematics, Science, English
- ii. *Grade 11, 1st semester (non-STEM)* – General Mathematics, Earth Science and Oral Communication
- iii. *Grade 11, 2nd semester (non-STEM)* - Statistics and Probability, Physical Science and Reading & Writing
- iv. *Grade 11, 1st semester (STEM)* – Pre-Calculus, Earth Science, Oral Communication
- v. *Grade 11, 2nd semester (STEM)* – Basic Calculus, General Chemistry, Reading & Writing

For Alternative Learning System applicants:

- i. Percentage of Correct Responses for Mathematical and Problem Solving Skills, Scientific Literacy & Critical Thinking and Communication Skills
- ii. *Grade 11, 1st semester (non-STEM)* – General Mathematics, Earth Science and Oral Communication
- iii. *Grade 11, 2nd semester (non-STEM)* - Statistics and Probability, Physical Science and Reading & Writing
- iv. *Grade 11, 1st semester (STEM)* – Pre-Calculus, Earth Science, Oral Communication
- v. *Grade 11, 2nd semester (STEM)* – Basic Calculus, General Chemistry, Reading & Writing

The Certification must be signed and certified correct by the Principal/ School Registrar, or equivalent school officer.

4. Wait for the confirmation from Testing and Admission Office (TAO); visit frequently the application tracker: (<https://dione.batstate-u.edu.ph/batstateucat/portal/#!/>).
5. Wait for the release of the BatStateU College Admission result; scheduled date of release shall be given by TAO.
6. For qualifiers, a Notice of Admission will be posted in the application tracker: (<https://dione.batstate-u.edu.ph/batstateucat/portal/#!/>).
7. Wait for the enrolment schedule.
